To the community that forms AFYL and to the philosophical community in general:

Every five years, the International Federation of Philosophical Societies (FISP) summons its member societies to organize the WORLD CONGRESS OF PHILOSOPHY (WCF). For over five editions, AFYL has presented an outstanding delegation at the event thanks to the enthusiasm, effort and ideas of students and academicians that collaborate producing and disseminating the ideas of the philosophical thought of liberation.

The WCF is an event that gathers an enormous number of academicians who represent the philosophical thought coming from very diverse currents and cultural backgrounds. Together, they built a forum that offers the extraordinary opportunity to create a dialogue and to meet other colleagues as well as their positions while interpreting the world. For the upcoming 2018 edition, as agreed during the last plenary assembly of FISP, the host city to the event will be Beijing, China, during the week between the 3rd and the 10th of August 2018.

- Mythical and symbolic reasons for Liberation

Proposals shall be sent in an .doc or .docx document written in arial 11



and must include a) Title, b) Abstract (250 words max.) c) Five keywords, d) Full name(s) and family name(s) of the author, e) nationality, f) University of origin, g) e-mail and contact phone number.

AFYL will not be responsible for the costs and travel expenses or any other viatical derived from the participation in the WCF. All the expenses will be the personal responsibility of the participant. Nevertheless, official acceptance letters will be issued to the

accepted participants, so that they can process economic support among the different financing sources existing in their places of origin or any other according to their interests.
